### A brief about the Fellowship Program (Part-Time/ Full- Time)

- The Fellowship Program aims to engage the young and dynamic youth of Mumbai who are passionate about leadership, teaching, and developing young minds from our schools to obtain high standards of Education and create promising career paths for their sustained growth.
- During this Fellowship will be assigned classes from the 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> Grades and 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Grades to teach designated subjects during the school timings.
- The Fellowship will be fully involved in all Scholastic and Co-scholastic

- activities in their respective schools.
- Capacity building and training will be provided to the selected candidates
- A continuous performance assessment is designed to evaluate the overall performance. The assessment will be based on their conduct, leadership qualities demonstrated, stakeholder management and the academic performance of the students.
- We will provide the Certificate to the Fellowship who successfully complete the tenure at the end of the program
- The fellowship will provide placement to suitable candidates based on their performances in the subject areas.

## Who can apply?

- 1) We are looking for candidates who are in under graduation or have a degree or above and are willing to teach public school children
- 2) Working Proficiency in the Hindi, Marathi, English is preferred

# **Training & Induction**

- 1) The selected candidate will be inducted into a 1-month training program.
- 2) Assessments will be conducted during this training program. Volunteers who cannot cope with the training will be relieved from the program.
- 3) Fellows will be allotted to their respective school during the program.

- 5. Successfully completing students will be selected for a Full-Time FELLOWSHIP Program or will be given further mentorship
